COMRADES MARATHON

The Comrades Marathon brings runners and visitors from South Africa and the world, to our city.

For safety reasons Msunduzi and KZN Traffic Authorities will be closing certain roads to motorists for a limited time on race day to ensure the safety of the runners on the route during the event.

We appreciate that the road closures may be of some inconvenience to you, and request that you plan your day around the closures accordingly as movement may be restricted.

We thank you for your patience, understanding and valued support of this iconic event. Come join us on the route during race day and show your friendly hospitality to those taking part. Please see the route map overleaf for the last 7km of the route and how it may potentially impact your day.

For ease of reference this is a detailed description of the last 7 km of the route:

From the top of Polly Shortts continue along C B Downes Road (R103) direction Pietermaritzburg, then turn right into Gladys Manzi Road (previously Murray Road), proceed over the N3 National Freeway and then left into Cleland Road (passing the Hayfields Shopping Centre on the RHS), and then left into Blackburrow Road and back over the N3 National Freeway, then right into Fairfield Avenue and then right into Ridge Road, crossing over New England Road with Ridge Road now becoming Harwin Road, then left into Taylor Street, proceeding all the way to the end, through the palisade fence and into the Scottsville Race Course complex.
